Riesling, Jekel (California)

Aromas and flavors of pear and apricot meld with heady honeysuckle.

Riesling Bridgeview "Blue Moon" (Oregon)

Flavors of ripe apples, apricot nectar and grapefruit with aromas of honeysuckle.

Pinot Grigio, Bella Sera (Italy)

Refreshingly crisp, with aromas of honeysuckle, pineapple and apricot. Subtle flavors of apple and pear.

Pinot Grigio, Ecco Domani (Italy)

Floral nose with delicate aromas of fig and lovely honeysuckle fruit. Excellent balance and a snappy finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Casa La Joya Reserva (Chile)

A classic Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of herbs and flowers with crisp, grassy flavors.

Vibrant notes of citrus, pineapple, flowers, minerals and lemon grass.

Vibrant aromas and flavors of pear, apple, citrus and tropical fruit.

Bright tropical fruit with a citrus top note and barrel spice. Flavors of pineapple and pear, with a touch of vanilla spice.

Shiraz, McWilliams Hanwood Estate (Australia)
\$25.00

Soft, rich, persistent black cherry fruit flavors integrated with vanilla and coffee bean characters.

Shiraz, Rosemount Estate (Australia)
\$23.00

A delicious berry and spice aroma. Soft, brambly palate with hits of pepper and spice.

Pinot Noir, MacMurray Ranch (Sonoma County)
\$40.00

Flavors of red and black cherries, roses and strawberries complimented by herb, spice and subtle vanilla characteristics.

Pinot Noir, Five Rivers (Sonoma County)
\$18.00

Toasted oak compliments the fruit character. These aromas combine with rich cherry and raspberry flavors in a balanced, medium-weight wine.

Zinfandel, Rancho Zabaco "Dancing Bull" (California)
\$25.00

Jammy raspberry fruit with hints of pepper. Soft, well-integrated tannins.

Merlot, Mirassou (California)
\$25.00

Fresh fruit flavors of dark plum, cherry and blackberry, balanced with elegant, toasty aromas and hints of spice.

Merlot, Robert Mondavi "Private Selection" (North Coast)

\$27.00

Silky, ripe berry and plum characters accented with violet and spice nuances.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Raymond "Amberhill" (California)

\$28.00

Spicy, woody aromas lead into a flavorful combination of berry and plum in this medium-bodied wine.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Rosemount "Hill of Gold" (Australia)

\$36.00

Underlying cassis and black currant elements on the palate. A vibrant palate of intense red berry fruit, mint and dark chocolate.

Shiraz/Cabernet, Rosemount Estate (Australia)

\$21.00

Ripe blackberry fruit and spicy undertones provide a smooth, fruity, soft finish.

Cabernet/Merlot, Rosemount Estate (Australia)

The Cab lends dark fruit richness, and the Merlot fulfills the classic role of a velvety, plummy richness to the finish.

Chianti, Da Vinci (Italy)
